No matter what the occasion, it's important to have just the right hat!

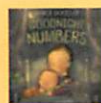


## **I Am (Not) Scared!** by Anna Kang

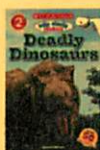
**Aaron Loves Apples and Pumpkins**
